

## Registration fees & information:

Registration for a new September school term opens at the beginning of January. Registrations are accepted in the order received and are non-refundable. You are invited to call for information. All classes are held depending upon enrollment.

## After you register:

You will receive confirmation of receipt of your registration. Your child will be invited to attend the Spring Open House in March. In July you will receive a packet which includes four forms to be completed and returned when school begins in September.

The July mailing will include tuition information. Select your method of payment (annual, semi-annual, quarterly, or monthly.) **First tuition is due August 15.**

**Tiny Tots** — \$284.00 (\$31.50 per month)

**2-Day Class** — \$636.00 (\$71.00 per month)

**3-Day Class** — \$930.00 (\$103.50 per month)

**4-Day Class** — \$1,271.00 (\$141.25 per month)

**1-Day Enrichment Class(October start date)** — \$333.00 (\$48.00 per month)

A letter from your child's teacher will be mailed late August including details about the first days of school. Preschool runs September – mid May.

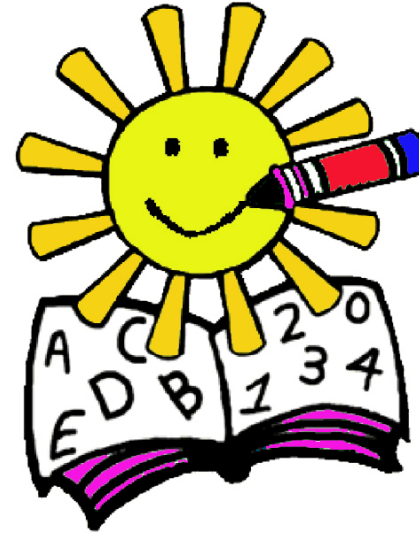
## Families' First Open House
