CONSISTORY HIGHLIGHTS by Denise Pfeifer, Consistory Sec.

The Treasurer reported that the month of November net income was a breakeven, and year to date net income had a \$17K loss. Liquidity improved to 79 days from 74 days. We were short about 12K in member contributions. Our cash is about \$38k, which is lower than previous months due to projects and building improvements.

- The Elders reported that the Preschool Director, Sean McKelvey, has turned in his resignation, effective 1/8/24. Consistory voted to accept his resignation and the Preschool Board has started the process of looking for a replacement for that position.
- The Consistory has voted on the decision to hire a Sexton to perform the janitorial duties for Trinity. The Sexton position is an employee position and will report to Pastor Chris.
- Approved Sue Bowman to serve on the Preschool Board (Class of 2023-26)
- Installation/Ordination of Consistory Members will take place at the 10:30 service on January 14.
- The election of officers for 2024 took place: President – Cherie Cataldi Vice President – Jeff Hackenberger Secretary - Denise Pfeiffer will continue until someone else comes forth. Treasurer – Denise Pfeiffer Financial Secretary – Dan Otthofer

CHURCH UNDECORATING SCHEDULED



TREASURE IN CLAY JARS by Rev. Jack Esbenshade

Our financial advisor has raised the guestion about how much risk we are comfortable with. He doesn't want to know if we plan on going skydiving or spelunking. He wants to know whether to invest our funds in securities and bonds or equities and stocks.

Some people seem to thrive on risk. I remember Evel Knievel and his white jump suit doing all sorts of amazing feats on his motorcycle or Karl and Nik Wallenda walking on the high wire. These folks are risk takers in my book.

We are on the threshold of a New Year. What do you need to secure and where will you risk? What will you keep safe and sound? Where/when will you push the envelope?

In Matthew 25 Jesus tells a parable about three servants who are entrusted with talents (5, 2 and 1). They exemplify the various approaches to security and risk. As the year 2024 opens to us, we each are receiving 366 days (8,784 hours). Where will you step out in faith? Will you risk doing something new or different? Will you join

a club or organization, volunteer your time in a new way, increase your charitable giving, set aside time each day or week for a spiritual exercise, make phone calls or send cards to the sick or shut-ins?

Will you invest your talents wisely in the days and hours ahead or will you simply hide what is given to you and reap no benefits?

The future has been made secure by our Lord Jesus. We simply need to step out in faith and move boldly into the New Year.






